Purpose of the meeting:

To consider the new work schedule for Navigational Lock Operators/Floodgate personnel.

LOCK WORK SCHEDULE

President Ronald Callais stated the purpose of the meeting was to re-visit the working schedule for the floodgate personnel.

Moved by Bobby Eymard, seconded by Monty Vegas and unanimously approved, the board resolved to schedule work shifts for all lock personnel (including probationary and permanent employees) on a five days on and five days off work schedule consisting of two-12 hour shifts per day to cover the 24 hour period. This schedule will become effective May 5, 2010. Due to anticipated needs over the next six months, the Board reserves the option to schedule lock personnel on a seven days on and seven days off shift. Although the Board has reserved the right to implement this optional seven-day schedule until November 5, 2010, this option does not create any agreement of contract with employees that guarantees employment through this period or thereafter. After November 5, 2010, the Board does not anticipate the need for any special seven-day scheduling and same will cease.

With no further business to discuss, the Board adjourned the meeting with a motion by EJ Gremillion, seconded by Roy Gisclair and unanimously carried.
